2. Applications should be submitted online through web portal www.manipurobcsc.mn.gov.in. The application will be screened at the district level through an online mode.

3. No offline forms will be issued and no forms shall be accepted physically.

4. **Last date for online form submission: 04-07-2026.**

5. **Eligibility of Beneficiaries as per the PM-AJAY Scheme:**

A. Individual:

- i. Age of beneficiary: above 18 years of age.
- ii. Priority shall be given to families / persons having annual income not more than Rs.2.50 lakhs per annum.
- iii. 30 percent of the beneficiaries shall be earmarked for women candidates in each trade.
- iv. 50 percent of the beneficiaries shall be earmarked for Internally Displaced persons from SC communities as per Government letter No. MISEC-2/1/2024-OBC & SC- OBC & SC, dated 30-08-2024.

B. Self Help Groups (SHGs):

- i. Registered Self-Help Groups working for SC communities may apply under the scheme.

6. The skill training is linked to provision for entitlement of assistance component, bank loan & beneficiary contribution. Tool kits will be provided to the beneficiaries upon successful completion of the training. However, there shall be beneficiary contribution and bank loan under the scheme.
7. The workflow of the Scheme is as follows:

Online Registration → Online Form Submission → District Level Verification → State Level Verification → Final Selection List → Commencement of Skill Training.
